

INTRODUCTION

FTS tracks funding for all humanitarian emergencies, whether directed to UN coordinated response plans, ICRC/IFRC or other entities. The Service also tracks bilateral contributions and private funding.

The FTS website is designed to provide different levels of information on reported humanitarian funding flows, from general overviews to specific, customized data searches. The displayed figures change automatically as soon as the database is updated.

If you are looking for a global summary of all humanitarian funding reported to FTS, just click on the "Global summary" label under the "Reported funding" menu item on the homepage.



GLOBAL SUMMARY PAGE: CONTENT - 1

The Global summary page shows the current year by default. Use the "Year" selector to retrieve data for a different year.

The "Highlights" pane displays the main global funding figures for the selected year.


GLOBAL SUMMARY PAGE: CONTENT - 2
