Overview of Humanitarian Funding

What Table 1 tells us → FTS processed **\$19.49 billion** humanitarian funding for 2024 as of 31 August 2024. This includes funding towards coordinated plans (**\$14.49 billion**) and funding falling outside the coordinated efforts (**\$4.99 billion**). GHO coverage for 2024 funding stands at **29.59 per cent** with GHO requirements in amount of **\$49.00 billion**.

What Table 2 tells us → ‘Food security’ has received one fourth of the total humanitarian funding in 2024. This is followed by “multiple sectors-shared” with **10.96 per cent**. Funding for “Health” ranks third with **9.61 per cent**. GBV funding increased by **\$81.90 million** from

2022 to 2023 but dropped one place in the overall ranking from 14th to 15th. GBV funding stands in 14th place as of 31 August 2024 with **\$282.17 million**, corresponding to **1.45 per cent** of the total humanitarian funding.

*“Multiple-sectors shared” refers to funding disbursed among more than one sector whilst “multi-sector” relates to refugees-focused humanitarian aids.

What Table 3 tells us → Consistent with the last two years, ROMENA ranks first with **23.40 per cent** (**\$4.56 billion**) of the total humanitarian funding in 2024 as of 31 August 2024. This is driven mainly by funding going towards the OPT with **8.67 per cent** of total humanitarian funding and ranking the first among all countries (**\$1.68 billion**), by the Syrian Arab Republic capturing **5.56 per cent** of total humanitarian funding (**\$1.08 billion**) and by Yemen with **4.57 per cent**, corresponding to **\$890.09 million**.

What Table 4 tells us → the OPT is the most funded country in 2024 with **\$1.68 billion** as of 31 August 2024. However, it was not among the top five both in 2022 and 2023 funding. Ukraine, ranked first in 2022 funding, second in 2023 funding and third in 2024 funding.

*The “Global” category is for HQ support and regional humanitarian operations.

What Table 5 tells us → Across the last three years, USA has been the top donor and provides **38.90 per cent** of the total humanitarian funding in 2024. Germany dropped from the second place -both in 2022 and 2023- to sixth in 2024. ECHO, ranked third in provision of 2022 and 2023 humanitarian funding, has risen to the second place in 2024. ECHO will phase out EDRIS bridge towards early 2025 and thus EU Member States will directly report into FTS.

What Table 6 tells us → WFP has remained the most funded organization in 2022, 2023 and 2024, receiving almost one fourth of the reported total humanitarian funding in 2024. UNHCR has occupied the second place and UNICEF the third both in 2023 and 2024 respectively. Confidential international NGOs rank fourth and IOM fifth in 2024 funding. Overall, the top five recipients have received **51.66 per cent** of the total humanitarian funding in 2024.

What Table 7 tells us → National and local organizations have received **2.21 per cent (\$430.25 million)** of the total humanitarian funding in 2024. National NGOs/CSOs constitute **1.00 per cent** out of this total, corresponding to **\$195.48 million**. The UN Agencies, Funds and Programmes have received **58.38 per cent (\$11.37 billion)** of 2024 funding, which is followed by international NGOs with **24.24 per cent (\$4.72 billion)**.

What Table 8 tells us → **74 per cent** of the 2024 total humanitarian funding (**\$14.49 billion**) went towards **43** coordinated plans consisting of **24** HRPs, **8** FAs, **9** RRP and **2** other types of plans. Outside GHO funding for 2024 stands at **26.00 per cent** with **\$4.99 billion** funding.

What Table 9 tells us → 24 HRPs constitute 76.13 per cent, 9 RRRs 10.88 per cent, 8 FAs 12.85 per cent and 2 other types of plans 0.15 per cent of 2024 total GHO funding as of 31 August 2024. As for the total requirements for 2024 standing at \$49.00 billion, breakdown is as follows: HRPs with 68.09 per cent, RRRs with 22.65 per cent, FAs with 9.04 per cent and other types of plans with 0.22 per cent.

2023 FUNDING ANALYSIS

KEY MESSAGES

- At the end of August 2024, FTS received and processed **\$35.61 billion** for 2023, up by **\$6.52 billion** from the **\$29.09 billion** reported at the end of December 2023. The additional funding is evenly distributed inside and outside the coordinated effort.
- Some **\$24.89 billion** are inside the coordinated effort (up from the **\$21.74 billion** reported at the end of 2023) and **\$10.78 billion** are outside the coordinated effort (up from **\$7.35 billion** reported at the end of 2023).
- Influenced by the additional reporting received throughout 2024 and the 2023 decrease in GHO requirements post December 2023 - from **\$56.7 billion** to **\$56.0 billion** - the 2023 GHO is now funded at **44.37 per cent** up from **38.35 per cent** at the end of 2023.
- All 2023 coordinated plans except for Haiti, Colombia, and RMRP Horn of Africa and Yemen show a funding increment since December 2023. Except for one (plus the three that show decreases), all coordinated plans gained **\$1 million** or more. The range from Ukraine with an additional **\$412.99 million** and Malawi with **\$459.978**. Two out of the six UNHCR coordinated RRP's (Syria and Ukraine) appear in the top 10 showing the highest increment of funding.
- The sectors gaining the most are “not specified” and “multi-sector”— close to **\$2.5 billion** collectively. These are followed by the Food Security, Health and Protection amounting to close to **\$2 billion**. The remaining amount (out of the **\$6.57 billion**) is divided among all other sectors, all gaining except for Emergency Telecommunication and Trafficking in Persons AOR both decreased due to corrections.
- The top five donors showing the biggest increases of funding towards 2023 through 2024 reporting are USA, Germany, Saudi Arabia, ECHO, Norway - the USA increasing by close to **\$2 billion** and Germany by close to a **\$1 billion**.
- 2023 reporting continues to come into FTS from both humanitarian contributors and recipients. **Since May 2024, a quick review shows that contributors like USA (BPRM), FCDO, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Australia, Norway and recipients like WFP, IOM, UNHCR and several INGOs like NRC, Acted, Plan International, World Doctors and others are reporting 2023 funding to FTS.**
