## Overview of Humanitarian Funding

**What Table 1 tells us** → FTS processed **\$11.58 billion** humanitarian funding as of 31 May 2024. This includes funding towards coordinated plans (**\$8.07 billion**) and funding falling outside the coordinated efforts (**\$3.51 billion**). GHO coverage for 2024 funding stands at **16.60 per cent** with GHO requirements in amount of **\$48.64 billion**.

**What Table 2 tells us** → 'Food security' and 'Health' rank the first and second respectively for the last three years in a row. Multiple sectors "shared" ranks third for both 2022 and 2024 whereas multi-sector "refugees" ranks the third in 2023 funding. GBV funding increased by **\$59.89 million** from 2022 to 2023 and yet dropped one place in the overall ranking from 14<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>. GBV funding is in the 13<sup>th</sup> place in overall sectoral ranking as of 31 May 2024 with **\$202.03 million**.

**What Table 3 tells us** → Consistent with the last two years, MENA ranks first with a **24.97 per cent (\$2.89 billion)** share of the total humanitarian funding in 2024 as of 31 May 2024. SEA takes the second place with **18.25 per cent (\$2.11 billion)** followed by WCA in the third place with **14.08 per cent (\$1.63 billion)** in 2024.

**What Table 4 tells us** → OPT is the most funded in 2024 receiving **\$1.06 billion** as of 31 May 2024. Ukraine, the most funded country in 2022 and 2023, places third in the first five months of 2024. The “Global” category for HQ support and regional operations ranks first in 2024. [At the request of partners, FTS is enabling a function that will allow greater granularity behind the global category given it also hides regional monies].

**What Table 5 tells us** → Across the last three years, USA has been the top donor. Germany dropped from the second both in 2022 and 2023, to the fourth in 2024. Instead, ECHO, ranked third in 2022 and 2023, and rose to the second place in 2024. Japan ranked fourth both in 2022 and 2023 and stands at third place in 2024. The top five donors provided **62.34 per cent** of total humanitarian funding for the 01 January 2024 – 31 May 2024 period.

**What Table 6 tells us** → WFP has remained the most funded organization in 2022, 2023 and 2024 receiving almost one fourth of the total humanitarian funding in 2024. For the last three years, UNICEF and UNHCR have occupied the second and third places. ICRC, ranked fifth in 2022, has risen to fourth place in 2024. Overall, the top five recipients have received **45.96 per cent** of the total humanitarian funding in 2024.

**What Table 7 tells us** → National and local organizations have received **2.23 per cent (\$258.37 million)** of the total humanitarian funding in 2024. This is far from meeting the 25 per cent commitment set out by Grand Bargain. The UN Agencies, Funds and Programmes are the most funded by receiving **57.06 per cent** of the total humanitarian funding in 2024.

**What Table 8 tells us** → **70 per cent** of the 2024 total humanitarian funding went towards the coordinated efforts by 31 May 2024. This corresponds to **\$8.07 billion** against the **\$48.64 billion** 2024 GHO requirements.

**What Table 11 tells us** → 2024 GHO consists of 39 plans as of 31 May: 24 HRPs, 5 FAs, 9 RRP and 1 other types of plans. GHO coverage stands at 16.60 per cent with \$48.64 billion requirements vs. \$8.07 billion actual funding. HRPs constitute 74.28 per cent, RRP 11.81 per cent, FAs 13.88 per cent and other types of plans 0.03 per cent of the total 2024 GHO funding.
